ATTLEBORO HIGH SCHOOL:

From the North – Take 95 S. to Exit 3B (Rt.123 B – 123 East). Take a left at the Texaco Gas Station – Lathrop Street, take a right onto Rome Blvd. Rome Blvd becomes Rathburn Willard Dr. High School will be on the right.

From the South – Take 95 N. to Exit 3A (Rt.123 B – 123 East). Take a left at the Texaco Gas Station – Lathrop Street, take a right onto Rome Blvd. Rome Blvd becomes Rathburn Willard Dr. High School will be on the right.

From the East – Take 95 S. to Exit 3B (Rt.123 B – 123 East). Take a left at the Texaco Gas Station – Lathrop Street, take a right onto Rome Blvd. Rome Blvd becomes Rathburn Willard Dr. High School will be on the right.

From the West – Take 95 S. to Exit 3B (Rt.123 B – 123 East). Take a left at the Texaco Gas Station – Lathrop Street, take a right onto Rome Blvd. Rome Blvd becomes Rathburn Willard Dr. High School will be on the right.

Babson College is located in Wellesley, Massachusetts. The campus is approximately 14 miles west of Boston.

From the East - Take the Massachusetts Turnpike to Exit 15 (Interstate 95/Route 128). After the tolls, follow signs to Route 95/128 South to Exit 20B (Route 9 West). Then follow "Route 9" directions below.

From the West - Take the Massachusetts Turnpike to Exit 14 (Interstate 95/Route 128). After the tolls, follow signs to Route 95/128 South to Exit 20B (Route 9 West). Then follow "Route 9" directions below.

From the South - Follow Route 95/128 North to Exit 20B (Route 9 West). Then follow "Route 9" directions below.

From the North - Follow Route 95/128 South to Exit 20B (Route 9 West). Then follow "Route 9" directions below.

From Route 9 - *From Exit 20B, continue on Route 9 West for approximately 2 miles and take the Route 16 exit. *At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 16 West (Washington Street). *Follow Route 16 West for 0.6 miles to Forest Street. *Turn left onto Forest Street and follow for 1.2 miles to Babson College; the main entrance is on the right.

BARNSTABLE HIGH SCHOOL: Mid-Cape Highway to exit 6 (Route 132) toward Hyannis. RIGHT off the ramp to next set of lights at Phinney's Lane. Go RIGHT on Phinney's. About 2 miles take a LEFT on Wequaquet Lane. Straight through lights at Route 28. At next lights go LEFT on West Main Street. BHS on LEFT. Take second entrance, the field is around back.

BAYSTATE GYMNASTICS:

From Points North –

Rte I-195 West to exit 12A. Take right off exit onto Faunce Corner Road. About a mile up there will be a major intersection with Dunkin Donuts on your left and a mall on your right. Take a right onto Rte 6

Follow through 4 sets of lights (you should go past Wal-Mart at this point). Go about a half-mile (you will pass a mini plaza with Healthy Grill, Cingular Wireless). Take a right onto Connecticut Avenue

The building will be on the left (Behind the Traditions Gift Shop). You can enter through the blue door.

From RI and Points West –

Rte I-195 east to exit 12. Take right off exit onto Faunce Corner Road. About a mile up there will be a major intersection with Dunkin Donuts on your left and a mall on your right. Take a right onto Rte 6

Follow through 4 sets of lights (you should go past Wal-Mart at this point). Go about a half-mile (you will pass a mini plaza with Healthy Grill, Cingular Wireless). Take a right onto Connecticut Avenue

The building will be on the left (Behind the Traditions Gift Shop). You can enter through the blue door.

BEVERLY ROLLER PALACE:

From the North – Rt 128 South to exit 19 (Music Theater) Left at end of off ramp. First right. Left at stop sign. Quarter of a mile on right. Look for Roller Skating sign on building

From the South – Rt. 128 North to exit 19 (Sohier Road). Straight off the ramp. Quarter of a mile on the right. Look for Roller Skating sign on building

BOSTON UNIVERSITY FITNESS AND RECREATION CENTER:

From the North – Take I-93 or Route 1 South to Boston. Exit onto Storrow Drive. Continue on Storrow Drive to the Kenmore Square Exit. At the light, make a right onto Beacon Street. Bear right at the far end of Kenmore Square onto Commonwealth Avenue. Continue on Commonwealth Avenue to the Fitness & Recreation Center (approx. 1 mile)

From the South – Take I-93 Route 3 (Southeast Expressway) North to Boston. Exit onto Storrow Drive. Continue on Storrow Drive to the Kenmore Square Exit. At the first set of lights, turn right onto Beacon Street. Bear right at the far end of Kenmore Square onto Commonwealth Avenue. Continue on Commonwealth Avenue to the Fitness & Recreation Center (Approx. 1 mile)

From the West – Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90) East. Take Exit 18 on the left (Brighton/Cambridge). Following signs to Cambridge. At the second set of lights, turn right. Continue on Storrow Drive to the Kenmore Square Exit. At the first set of lights, turn right onto Beacon Street. Bear right at the far end of Kenmore Square onto Commonwealth Avenue.

BRIDGEWATER STATE COLLEGE:

At next traffic light turn left onto Seaver Street follow to left on Walnut street White Stadium is .5 miles on left.

From the West - Follow Rt. 90 Mass Pike East to 128. Take 128 S to exit 2b, Rt. 138 toward Milton. Follow Rt. 138 past Curry College to Mattapan Square. Slight left at light and road becomes Blue Hill Ave. Follow crossing Morton Street and continuing to Franklin Park Zoo on the left. At next traffic light turn left onto Seaver

WRENTHAM DEVELOPMENT CENTER: From Route 95 - Take Mechanic Street exit to Foxboro. In Foxboro Center, take Route 140 West to Wrentham. Continue on Route 140 through Wrentham Center. About 1/2 mile 140 will bear left, STAY TO THE RIGHT onto Shears Street. Take second RIGHT onto Emerald Street.

YELLOW JACKETS GYMNASTICS:

From the West:

- I-495N to Exit 42A: RT-114E toward Middleton.
- Continue East on RT-114 for ~7 miles.
- After the Meritor Academy on the left, turn left onto Lookout Lane.
- Yellow Jackets is on the left. Look for the Yellow Jacket awning.

From the North:

- I-95S to Exit 51: Endicott Rd.
- Turn right off the exit.
- Continue on Endicott Rd/East St. for ~2 miles.
- Turn right at the first traffic light onto Maple St/RT-62.
- Travel ~1.2 miles and turn right at the first traffic light onto S. Main St/RT-114.
- After ~2 miles, turn right onto Lookout Lane. Look for a boat yard.
- Yellow Jackets is on the left. Look for the Yellow Jacket awning.

From the South Through Boston:

- I-93N / US-1N to Exit 27 on Left: RT-1N toward Tobin Bridge/Revere
- Take the Exit for Andover St./RT-114W
- After ~5.3 miles, turn right onto Lookout Lane. Look for a boat yard.
- Yellow Jackets is on the left. Look for the Yellow Jacket awning.

From the South Around Boston:

- I-95N / RT-128N. When I-95N and RT-128N split, stay right to stay on I-95N.
- Take Exit 47B: Andover St./RT-114W toward Middleton.
- After ~5.7 miles, turn right onto Lookout Lane. Look for a boat yard.
- Yellow Jackets is on the left. Look for the Yellow Jacket awning.

ATHLETES WHO TRAIN IN MULTIPLE SPORTS PER SEASON

In an effort to maximize opportunities for athletes to train, compete and grow:

- **Training:**
 - Athletes are permitted to train in multiple sports per season.
- **Pre-State Competition:**
 - Athletes are permitted to compete in only one Assessment Round per sport (so as not to interfere with the divisioning process for the State Games).
 - Athletes are permitted to compete in Assessment Rounds for other sports if they are training in multiple sports.
 - If you are going on to compete at State Games, you are required to compete in the respective Assessment Round (if applicable) for the sport that you will compete in at State Games.
 - Athletes are permitted to compete in any other Invitational, Sectional, Area or Local Competition in any other sport they are training in.
- **State Competition:**
 - However, athletes must select one sport to compete in at State Games by the Final Registration deadline.

Definition of Terms:

- **Assessment Round –**
 - A competition held prior to State Games to record/assess athlete/team ability levels to allow for divisioning for State Games.
 - Athletes are **required** to attend Qualifies before attending State Games.
 - Assessment Rounds are held for team sports that have more than 12-15 teams training.
 - Assessment Rounds are held for individual sports that have more than 50 athletes training.
 - Area Games are considered Assessment Rounds by definition.
- **Invitational –**
 - Competitions that athletes are *invited* to compete in, as an additional competition opportunity, but are not required.
 - Are often held for those sports that do not have enough participants training in to constitute holding a Assessment Round.
- **Sectional, Area or Local Competition –**
 - Any additional competition held regionally by Section, Area or Local Program.
