<p>Community Boating Inc. 21 David Mugar Way Boston, MA</p>	<p><b>From the North</b> Take 93 into Boston. Take the Storrow Drive West Exit off 93. Take your first left exit off Storrow Drive(Government Center/Kendall Square). Enter the Charles Street rotary following signs for Storrow Drive West. You will see the on-ramp for Storrow Drive West. Do not go up the ramp, but instead look to the left for a large blue sign that says "MASS EYE AND EAR PARKING". Take a ticket and park. Instead of going towards the hospital, walk out of the parking lot the same way you came in, heading towards Charles Street. To the right you will see a footbridge which will take you over Storrow Drive and towards the Charles River. Cross this footbridge and when you arrive at the end go down the stairson your left and Community Boating will be right in front of you.</p> <p><b>From the West</b> - Take the Boston/Cambridge exit (#18). Stay right up and over the ramp and follow through one set of lights. At the second set of lights before the river, take a right at the Double Tree Suites Hotel onto Storrow Drive East. While on Storrow Drive, stay in the left lane and follow signs for Downtown Boston. After passing the Hatch Shell on your left (the large half dome), take the next right exit off Storrow Drive (Government Center/Kendall Square). Enter the Charles Street rotary following signs for Storrow Drive West. You will see the on-ramp for Storrow Drive West. Do not go up the ramp, but instead look to the left for a large blue sign that says "MASS EYE AND EAR PARKING". Take a ticket and park. Instead of going towards the hospital, walk out of the parking lot the same way you came in, heading towards Charles Street. To the right you will see a footbridge which will take you over Storrow Drive and towards the Charles River. Cross this footbridge and when you arrive at the end go down the stairs on your left and Community Boating will be right in front of you.</p> <p><b>Parking</b> - Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary (MEEI) gives Community Boating members and guests parking discounts at their facility. Parking discounts are only available Monday -Friday after 5 p.m. and weekends and holidays after 9 a.m.-10 p.m. Parking validation is available at Community Boating for \$5. You must provide your parking ticket and it must be time stamped within the appropriate time in order to redeem the discount.</p>
<p>Framingham High School 115 A Street Framingham, MA</p> <p>Walsh Middle School 301 Brook Street Framingham, MA</p>	<p><b>To Framingham High School</b> <b>From the Mass Pike</b> exit 13 - (Natick - Framingham - Rt. 30): Bear right onto Rt. 30. ½ mile then right onto Rt. 126 (Concord St.). Go 1 mile on Concord St., under the Mass Pike overpass by 50 yds and turn left onto A St. The school is ¼ mile on the left.</p> <p><b>From Route 9</b> - (Worcester Rd.): Take the Rt. 126 North exit. Go 1 mile on Rt. 126 (Concord St) staying left at the intersections of Rt. 30 and at Old Connecticut Path. Go under the Mass Pike overpass by 50 yds and turn left onto A St. The school is ¼ mile on the left. Visitors parking is straight ahead.</p> <p><b>Directions to Walsh Middle School</b> <b>From the North:</b> I-95 South to I-90, Mass Pike West. Take Mass Pike Exit 13, Route 30 toward Natick/Framingham. Turn Right to proceed on Route 30 (Cochituate Road) toward Framingham. Keep Right to stay on Route 30 (Worcester Road). Turn Right to stay on Route 30 (Edgell Road). Stay Straight on Edgell Road until Right hand turn onto Brook Street. Walsh Middle School is at 301 Brook Street.</p> <p><b>From the South &amp; West:</b> I-495 North toward Worcester. Take Exit 22, Mass Pike East. <p>Langone Field North End Commercial Street Boston, MA</p>	<p><b>NOTE:</b> Due to remnants of the Big Dig, this area will be under construction and changes to these directions may arise. Also, traffic delays are probable. Please plan accordingly.</p> <p><b>FROM THE NORTH -</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take Interstate 93S to Exit 26A (Leverett Circle/Cambridge) and follow the signs for North Station. After exiting, get in right lane, and turn RIGHT at the end of the ramp.</li> <li>• Stay straight through one set of lights (you'll see the back of the big Fleet Center building ahead on your left).</li> <li>• At the next stoplight, turn LEFT onto Lomasney Way.</li> <li>• Go ¼ mile to next light, and turn LEFT onto Causeway Street.</li> <li>• Go past the Fleet Center on your left. Langone Field is about ½ mile down on the left (Note: Causeway St. becomes Commercial St. during this stretch as you enter the North End). The Bocce Courts are in between the MDC Skating Rink and the two softball fields on Commercial Street. You must park on the street.</li> </ul> <p><b>FROM THE WEST -</b> Take Mass Pike (I-90) East to 93 North Tunnel. Follow directions from 93N Tunnel below.</p> <p><b>FROM THE SOUTH -</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take Interstate 93N to Boston. Enter the 93N Tunnel.</li> <li>• Take Exit 26 (Storrow Drive/North Station). There are two lanes on this exit ramp; stay in the left lane. At fork in exit ramp, bear left and follow signs for North Station.</li> <li>• As you approach the 1st stoplight after the fork, get in the right hand lane. Go through the 1st stoplight, still following signs to North Station.</li> <li>• Go through 2nd stoplight (you'll see the back of the big Fleet Center building ahead on your left). <p>Medway High School 88 Summer Street Medway, MA</p>	<p><b>From the East -</b> Take the Mass Pike West to Exit 11A - 495. Merge onto 495 South. Take Exit 19 for MA-109/Medway toward Milford. Turn left at MA-109 East, follow for 2.2 miles. Turn left on to 126 Noroth/Summer Street. High School will be on the right.</p> <p><b>From the West -</b> Take Mass Pike to Exit 11A-495. Merge onto 495 South. Take exit 19 for MA-109/Medway toward Milford. Turn left at MA-109 East, follow for 2.2 miles. Turn left on to 126 North/Summer Street. High School will be on the right.</p> <p><b>From the South -</b> Take 95 North to Exit 6B-495 North. Merge on to 495 North and follow to exit 18MA-126. Turn right at Hartford Avenue/MA-126N. Follow for 1.6 miles. Turn left at Old Summer Street. Continue on MA-126N/Summer Street. High School will be on right.</p> <p><b>From the North -</b> Take 495 South to exit 19 for MA-109/MEdway toward Milford. Turn left at MA-109 East, follow for 2.2 miles. Turn left on to 126 North/Summer Street. High School will be on the right.</p>
<p>Mt. Hood Golf Course 100 Slayton Road Melrose, MA</p>	<p><b>From North:</b> From route 1 (north and south) Take Exit Essex Street Melrose. (Burger King on the southbound side and Walgreens on the northbound side.) Essex St. becomes Upham St. in Melrose. Go past the Incarnation church and take your next left after the gas station onto Waverly St. Follow to the stop sign and take a slight left onto Slayton Road. Follow to the top of the hill.</p> <p><b>From Route 93 going North from Boston</b> Take Exit 33-Fellsway/Rte. 28. Keep to the right, do not go around the rotary, and follow the signs for Rte. 28. Go about ½ mile to the blinking light, take a right. Follow to the end and take a left at MDC skating rink. You will pass an office park on your right. Take your second right onto Pond Street. At set of lights (Grimsbys) continue straight (Pond St. becomes Wyoming Ave, after the light). Follow past the railroad tracks. Take a left at the lights onto Main Street. At third set of lights take a right onto Upham Street. Go straight for about ¾ of a mile. Take a right onto Waverly St before gas station Follow up to the stop sign. Make a slight left and follow to the top of the hill.</p> <p><b>From West:</b> From 128 going North from the Mass Pike 128 North to the first Wakefield exit 39 (North Ave) at end of ramp take right continue straight to Main Street Wakefield, take a right on Main street. Follow straight into Melrose Center. Take left at Melrose City Hall onto Upham St. Go straight for about ¾ of a mile. Take a right onto Waverly St before gas station Follow up to the stop sign. Make a slight left and follow to the top of the hill.</p>
